Monthly Tips...

Copper Patina:

We have so many requests from clients not attending classes for advice on how to apply copper patina, so here are a few tips:

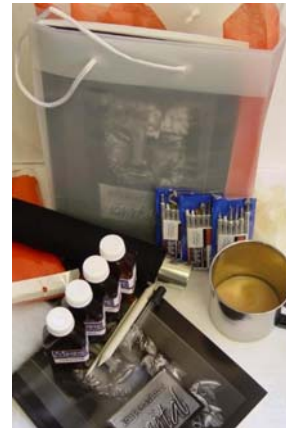
- Apply black patina to your completed work and polish as normal.
- Select the areas that you would like to apply copper.
- Apply the copper patina with a paint brush - pour a little copper patina into the lid of the bottle (remember not to contaminate the contents by dipping the brush into the bottle.)
- Wipe the brush onto carton towel after each application.
- You may have to paint over an area two or three times before you get a good copper finish.
- Dab the work area with dry carton towel between each application.
- Buff with dry cloth or cotton wool when finished. Do not apply polish.
- This is just one technique, experiment to create different finishes.

- Impressions in Metal – Instruction & Design Book
- ¼ m pewter
- 3 sets of imported tools (6 tools in each set)
- Consumables – lubricator, cleaner, patina & polish
- Mug of wax plus dropper
- Felt, polishing cloth, fibre
- 2 Paper stubs

Content: This workshop is an intensive hands on workshop. In the morning you will complete a book cover, learning low relief, high relief, various other techniques and understanding the full process of pewter repoussé.

After lunch you will create a face in pewter. The process of creating a high relief face is an important one as the step by step process

teaches you to understand a 'realistic' 2-D drawing and to interpret it in a 3-D way. Once you understand the logics of creating a face in pewter you can tackle anything in pewter!
