## NEW ON THE SHELVES



**W**e have launched our very own new vibey and modern range of beautifully finished boxes ready to personalise with your pewter work. The boxes have a very dark finish (somewhere between black and Mahogany) They are factory sprayed with a high quality sheen and beautifully finished inside with a black sprayed fabric coating. The base of the boxes has the same quality finish as well as little rubber 'feet' for protection.

We have modernised the boxes by creating simpler lines. The finish inside is awesome and upmarket. New in the studio is a wine box or liquor box which makes a stylish gift for a man, holds a bottle of his favourite wine, whiskey or liqueur. We also have a wonderful smaller box for precious little gifts or small keepsakes. The trays are gorgeous and modern with no cut outs on the sides (not like the old ones we had) enabling you to do high relief and not worry about the liquid glass levels. The range will be extended from time to time and A5 and A4 wooden books will be added to the range shortly.

## Saturday Beginner Workshops



Dates: Saturday 7th November

Time: 9h00 – 15h30

Cost: R1 500

Price includes: Full kit with imported tools, "Impressions in metal" book, pewter and all relevant consumables and requirements, a miniature book for the morning project, a tin for the afternoon project. Coffee, tea, morning muffins, and lunch.

Content: This workshop is an intensive hands on workshop. In the morning you will complete a book cover, learning low relief, high relief, various other techniques and understanding the full process of pewter repoussé.

After lunch you will create a face in pewter. The process of creating a high relief face is an important one as the step by step process

teaches you to understand a 'realistic' 2-D drawing and to interpret it in a 3-D way. Once you understand the logics of creating a face in pewter you can tackle anything in pewter!
